
Employees of eligible Erie Regional Chamber businesses can enroll in certain online or on-campus master's programs or graduate certificate programs at a cost of only **\$1,755 per three-credit course**—a savings of up to 30 percent.

These significant tuition savings apply to the following graduate programs:



CYBER RISK MANAGEMENT • MASTER'S PROGRAM (ONLINE)

This program integrates traditional elements of risk management with cutting-edge science in big data and cyber security, providing you with the skills to assess and monetize cyber risk, protect networked devices and intellectual property, and communicate complex cyber information. Coursework highlights the technical, legal and business aspects of cyber risk management. Successful completion of the coursework also earns students two course waivers toward the prestigious Chartered Property Casualty Underwriter (CPCU) designation from The Institutes.



CYBER SECURITY • MASTER'S PROGRAM (ONLINE) OR GRAD CERTIFICATE (ONLINE)

This program prepares you to analyze cyber threats to computer systems, networks and networked devices, and protect those systems from cyber attacks. You'll also learn to evaluate the legal, regulatory and ethical issues related to cyber security and privacy, and effectively communicate complex cyber security information. Program grads will be well positioned to pass the CompTIA's Security+ certification, ISC2's Systems Security Certified Practitioner (SSCP) certification, and ISC2's Associate designation.



APPLIED INTELLIGENCE • MASTER'S PROGRAM (ONLINE OR ON CAMPUS) OR GRAD CERTIFICATE (ONLINE)

One of the first and most respected programs of its kind, Mercyhurst's master's program in Applied Intelligence prepares you with the skills to lead analytical teams in national security, international relations, law enforcement and competitive business. This program focuses on intelligence as a process, evaluating information from multiple sources and communicating analytic findings to assist with setting strategy, policy and other high-level decisions.



DATA SCIENCE • MASTER'S PROGRAM (ON CAMPUS)

This master's program prepares individuals to serve as data-driven informants for decision-makers in both the public and private sectors. The cross-disciplinary curriculum emphasizes programming, data visualization, machine learning, database skills and quantitative analysis to produce graduates who are innovators in producing, visualizing and communicating actionable new insights about the meaning of data for businesses, public agencies and nonprofits. Additionally, the program's applied focus offers students exposure to real-world scenarios and situations.

These programs are designed to allow both recent college graduates and working professionals to earn a master's degree in approximately two years, or a grad certificate in less than a year. In addition, individuals from any educational or professional background can succeed and gain mastery of the concepts in any of these programs. **No prior IT or programming experience is needed.**
